Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has attempted to enhance and institutionalize quality assurance in institutional activities during the period from 2017-18 to 2021-22. The details of which are summarized as below:-

Quality initiatives and achievement of IQAC

Teaching-Learning support facilities:

- Number of classrooms and smart class rooms increased significantly. During 2nd Cycle NAAC-Visit college had 22 Class rooms, 02 Smart class room and 01 Auditorium with LECD projector.Currently 28 Class rooms, 06 Smart class rooms and 01 Auditorium (an increase around 32% and 133% respectively) with modern teaching equipments
- In 2016 altogether 14 computers were for academic purpose presently it is 72, where it has been increased by 400%
- Reading rooms for faculty members with AC and interior decoration-which newly erected
- Separate academic deptt. with adequate furniture and modern teaching- learning toolswhich totally newly arranged
- Number books in 2016 around 22000 and E- resources whereas in 2022 it's around 24000 along with e-resources, journals, daily newspapers and numerous other facilities
- Book Bank facilities is presently available in most of the departments
- Library modernization with barcode system, installation of own server and running of KOHA software: newly installed and there by library has now been partly automated
- Reading room for the students with AC-where space has made almost treble with interior decoration and AC facility
- Two large stack Room for easy accession and searching of books: one more stack room has newly been erected
- Computer lab accommodating 16 computers with AC-where capacity has made nearly doubled and spacious with AC facility
- Career Counseling and Placement Cell- newly made with planned system and action
- Incubation centre for motivating students towards entrepreneurship/start up- newly been arranged
- College's own app and central sound system for digital and smooth communicationwhich have totally newly installed
- Green belt has newly been increased to three times of the existing
- Lavatory both of boys and girls and safe drinking water has now become almost three times
- Indoor game hall for boys and girls- that's are spacious and well
- Outdoor games facility for badminton, cricket, and football has now adequately been arranged
- Multi Gym hall for all with adequate instruments

Teaching-learning and evaluation:

- ICT classes by faculty members (more than 50% of classes has now made compulsory)
- Ice braking, aptitude Test with newly enrolled students for systematically dissemination
 of necessary information on teaching-learning, courses, marks distribution, exam
 pattern etc. and also to have knowledge of the new entrants and to plan teachinglearning—as innovative practices
- To apprise the students of Course outcomes (COs) and Programme outcomes (POs) in offline and online mode(college's website)
- Conduction of various Add-on courses including job oriented, soft skill, language skill, It's now 30 Add-on courses have already concluded recently-all have newly conducted
- Follow up of status of syllabus progression and completion periodically and systematically-all are resolved in the minutes of the department and noted in the meeting of the Academic sub committee
- Analysis of all continuous internal evaluations(CIEs) and to classify of slow learners and advanced learners
- Arrangement of Remedial classes for slow learners and use of advanced learners as a speaker in the students' Seminar, summarizing lecture etc.
- Conduction of various seminars/webinars on cross cutting issues and awareness generation for the students-enhanced
- Faculty exchange programme both of interdepartmental and inter-college-newly started
- Students' seminars/Extempore/Quiz etc. of all departments-has made a part CIEs
- Soft skill programme has made compulsory for the students departmentally
- To follow up of Programme Attainment(PAs) of each deptt.
- Assignment of Projects -newly introduced for enhancement of analytical skill of the students
- Outreach programme -newly introduced for subjects' exposure of the students

Research and publications:

- 20 operational MoUs with various institutions for faculty exchange and research facilities
- Publication of research articles in reputed journals, books and book chapters increased significantly
- Pursuing Ph.D is on increase
- Ph.D. supervision is done
- Research journal INQUEST- (with ISSN- 2349-5472) is regularly published and recently got recommendation from the affiliating university for CARE- list
- Institutional magazine and wall magazines- frequency of publication has now been increased
