Concept Note

Issues regarding the well-being of one's mental or psychological state have always been a significant concern. While physical ailments tend to receive immediate and effective administration in society, mental ailments are often perceived with a peculiar mixture of disdain, distrust and condescension. Individuals suffering from any psychological disorder have therefore frequently been stigmatized by society in general and such negligence or indifference towards both the disorder and the individual(s) suffering from it has characterized both the eastern and the western world over the course of a considerable period of time.

Literature, however, has always been an invaluable medium for drawing attention to such repressed issues. From the ancient classical world of Greece and Rome where the idea of insanity was more aligned with the notion of the irrational than a pathological condition as such to Shakespeare's characters who alternate between feigning madness to actually succumbing to it, from the 'madwoman in the attic' who came to epitomize, as it were, the undeniable injustices of Victorian life to the modern era when insanity, depression and other

mental illnesses have come to claim so many lives, mental health has been a recurrent theme whose significance cannot be overstated. Philosophers and thinkers, from Aristotle to Freud to Foucault, have also showcased similar concerns in their works which have been instrumental in formulating entire theories of madness and other mental disorders.

The purpose of this webinar is to highlight the importance of engaging with questions related to mental health, especially in the context of the Indian society where such issues are mostly considered taboo. Investigations into the construction of what is deemed normative and what constitutes deviation, the politics of exclusion, the extent of cultural determinism in defining madness, and the prejudices that condition the attitude towards certain vulnerable groups of people that become effective in categorizing them as mentally unstable or volatile are all integral to a deeper and more sympathetic understanding of mental health and its associated concerns. In conclusion, it

is expected that an intense critical engagement by scholars and researchers with the topic will enable us, at the very least, to contribute fruitful insights and ideas to a meaningful debate in academia and thereby help generate a deeper understanding about an issue that seems to be becoming increasingly relevant in today's world.

Sub-themes

Year 2020 observes the bicentennial birth year of Pandit Iswar Chandra Vidyasagar. He is regarded as one of the prominent intellectuals in the making of modern Bengal. The Bengalee society owes its traits of modernity and progressiveness to Vidyasagar. The birth of modern and progressive Bengal was possible due to tireless efforts of people



like him. His rationality, humanism and strong sense of commitment to emancipate women inspired him to initiate reform programmes to rescue the Bengali society which was hitherto immersed in the darkness of illiteracy, superstition and abject neglect of women folk. His firm faith in humanism induced him to introduce widow re-marriage and ban on child marriage and polygamy. Despite stiff opposition from the orthodox section of Bengalee hindus, he arranged widow remarriage, and succeeded to convince the Ra to promulgate laws in this regard. His faith in the efficacy of education in bringing about desired changes in the then contemporary society encouraged him to spread education and establish schools in different parts of Bengal.

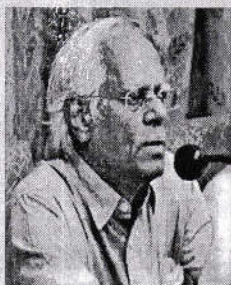
