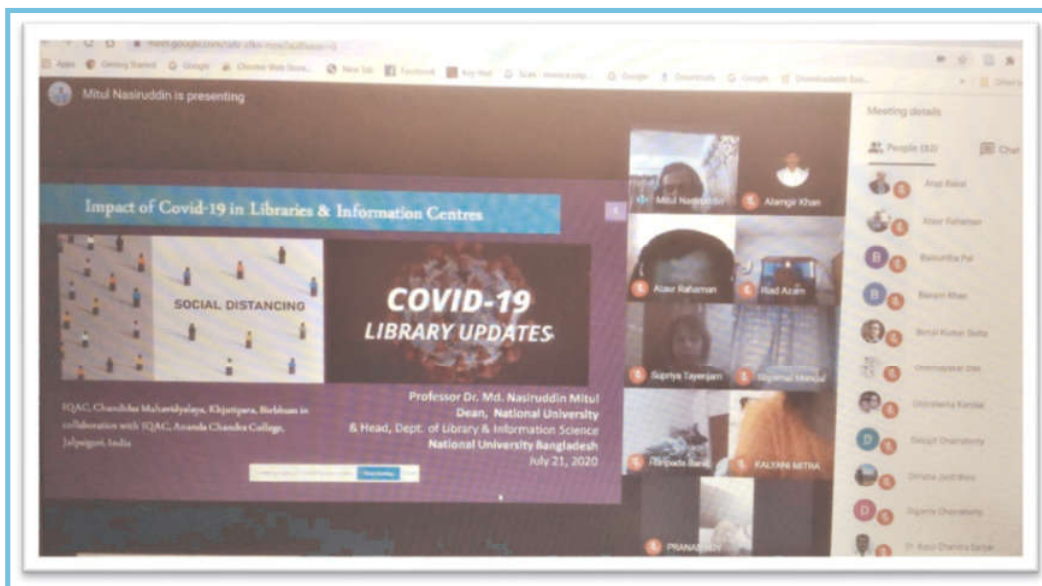
About Technical Sessions

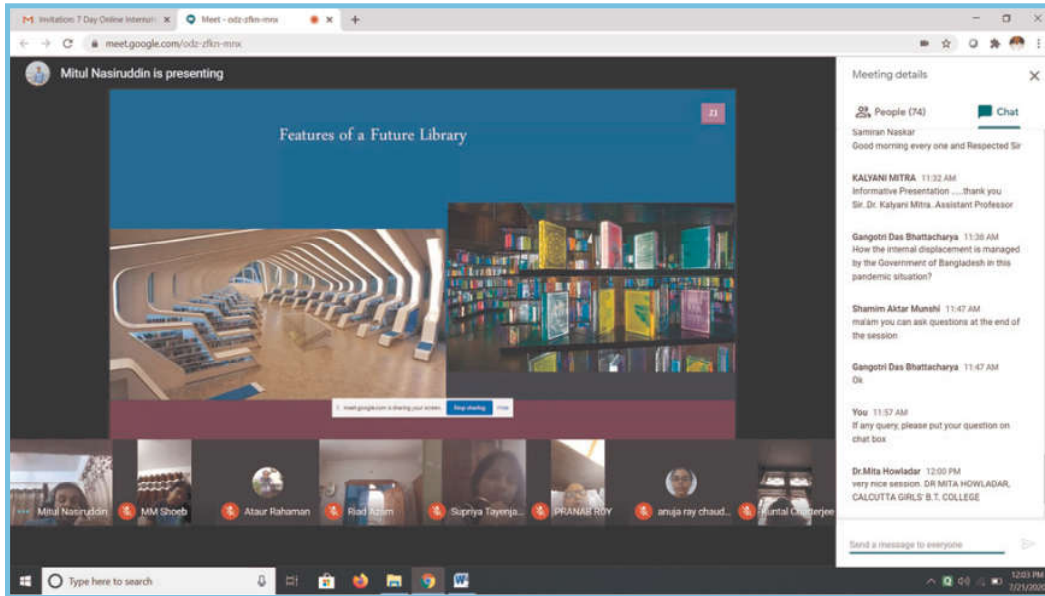
Technical Session:1

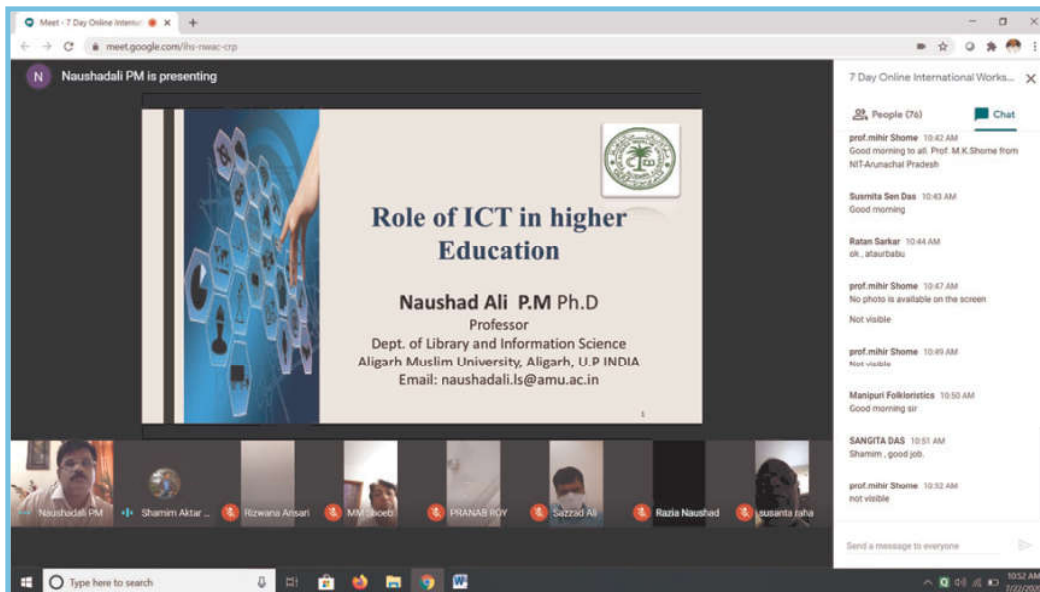

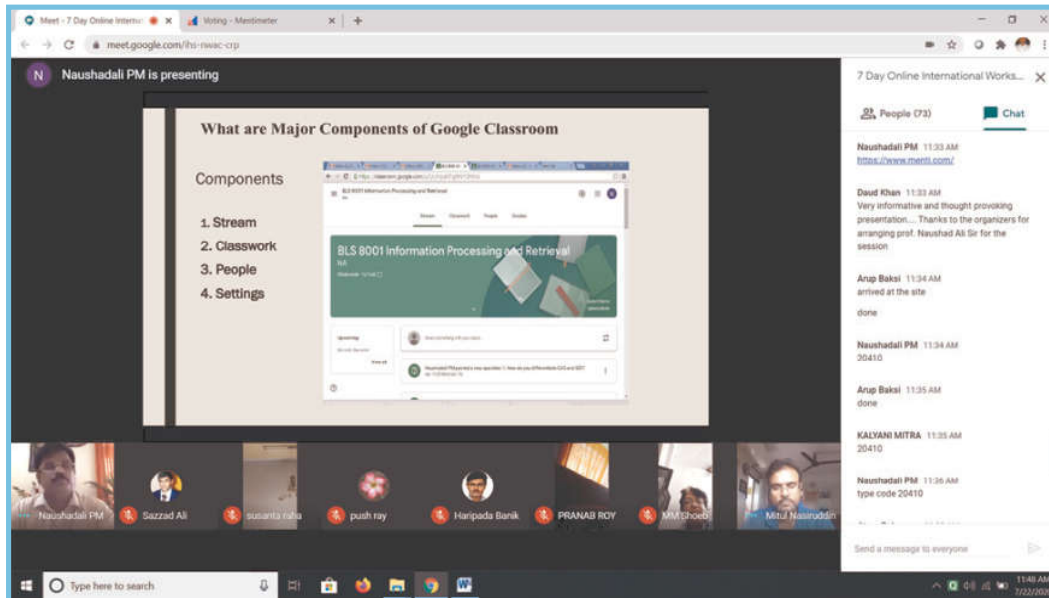
Technical Session:2

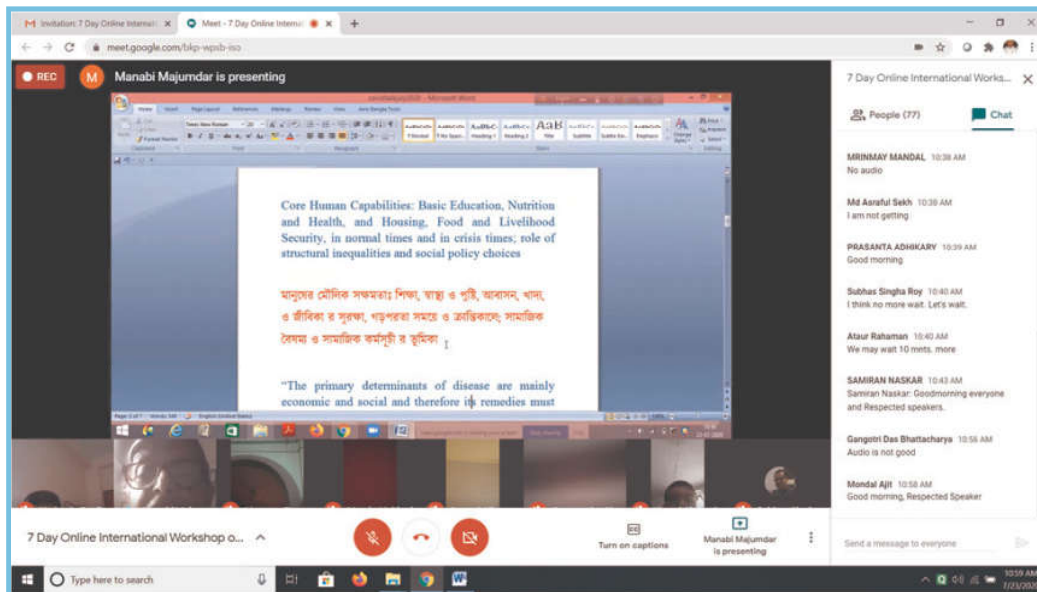

He presented many challenges which have derived from the present crisis such as transitioning to online learning from physical learning. He categorically pointed out that the pandemic has forced us to create physical distance and thereby we have been forced to expose to access technology inventively. He has demonstrated hands on training on ‘Google Classroom’. Day 3, 23rd July, Thursday, 2020

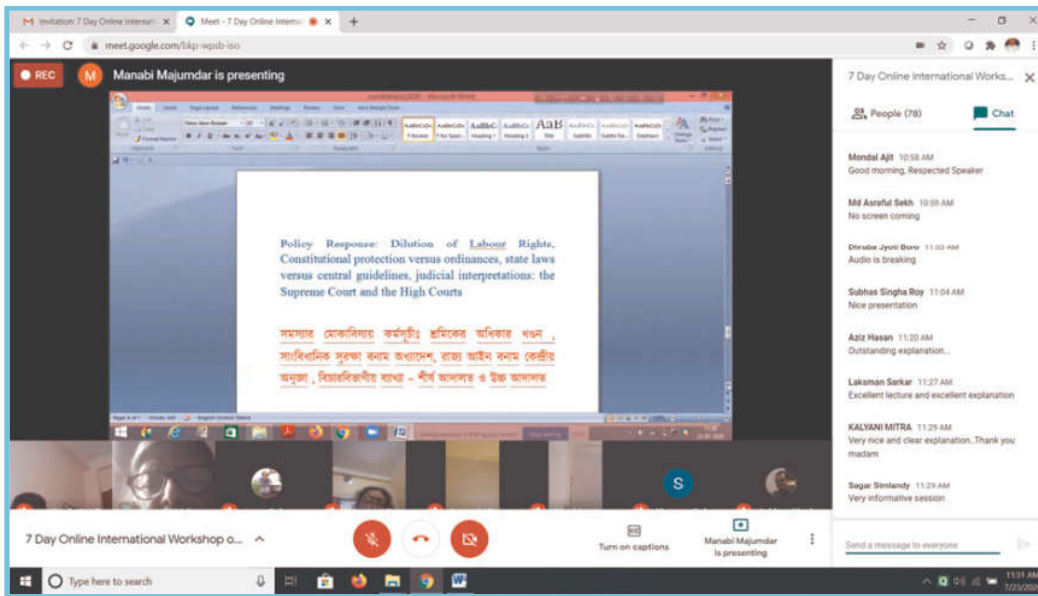
Technical Session: 3

Professor Majumdar emphasised on Planned Social Policies like-public action, Govtt. initiatives and politics in respect of nurturing of human capabilities in the crisis and categorically mentioned that human capability is required to be enhanced during this crisis periods. She said that in the normal situations, poor people as such suffered to have the minimum facilities like nutritious food, medical attention, shelter, education and decent income. So in the Covid-posed threats the plight of the below poverty line people becomemuch worsen. The condition of the migrant labourers is a shame for the nation. She fingered on the revision of labour laws by the Government, which is against the interest of the labourers and pointed out that judiciary has been divided over the consequences of the dilution of labour laws. Besides, she drew our attention to the plight of sanitary workers, safai karmachari and health workers. She also suggested that PDS, MGNREGA, Public Transport System and Public Health

System should be strengthened to mitigate the distress. Also she suggested that migrant workers might change their profession on compulsion of struggle.

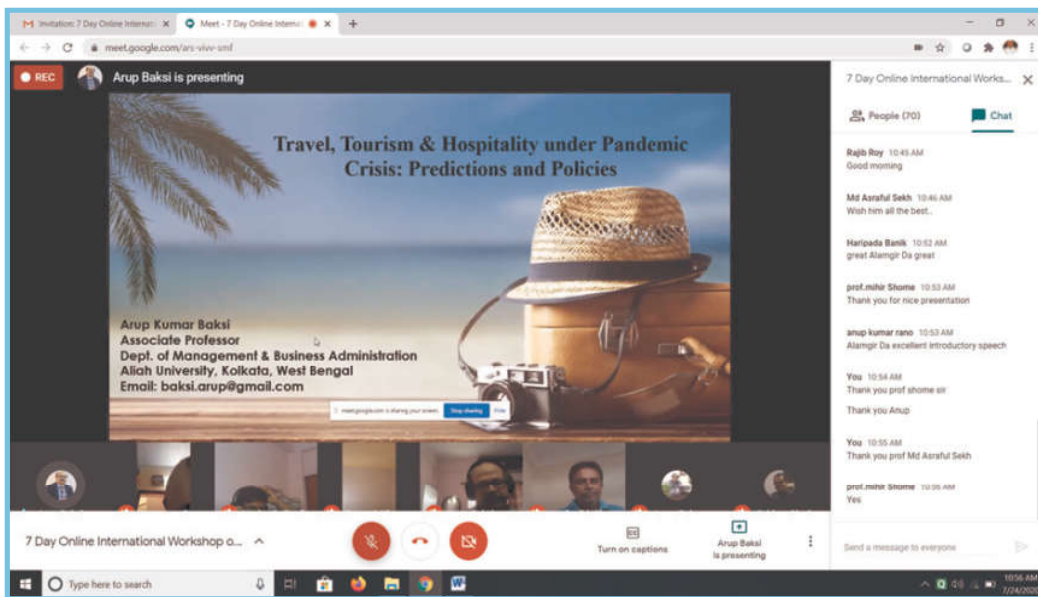
After her deliberation participants were seen engaged with clearing their queries and doubts. She answered all queries satisfactorily.

Prof. Baksi reflected upon the miserable condition of travel and tourism & hospitality industries throughout the world. He made a very informative and attractive speech on the nature of loss in the tourism sector. With latest data and information along with the related theories, he presented the policy prescriptions. He said that India is one of the main attractions of foreign tourists and it contributes 11% of GDP and therefore India face huge losses. He elaborated several governments' bailout package in the world to revive these industries and in the same tune he suggested some of the measures be undertaken by the Government of India to rescue these industries like- reduction in tax, financial assistance to the persons involved with this sector etc. On the other hand he emphasised on some of the techniques and processes that can also be followed by the service providers to attract tourists-like cleanliness of the site and sitting area, hygienic system of serving of food, transparency of

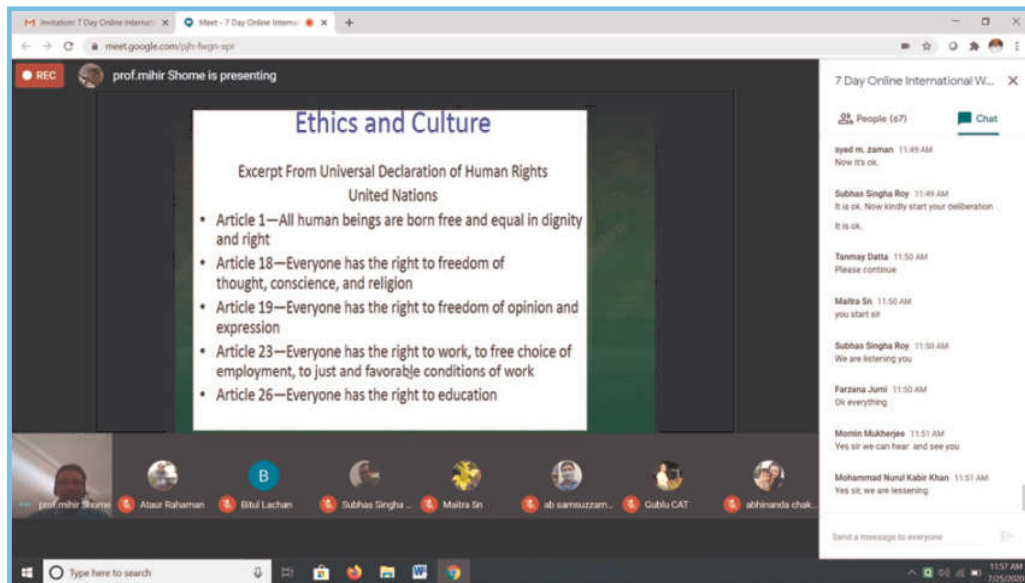
kitchen etc. There was very interactive privilege at the question-answer period and was enjoyable.

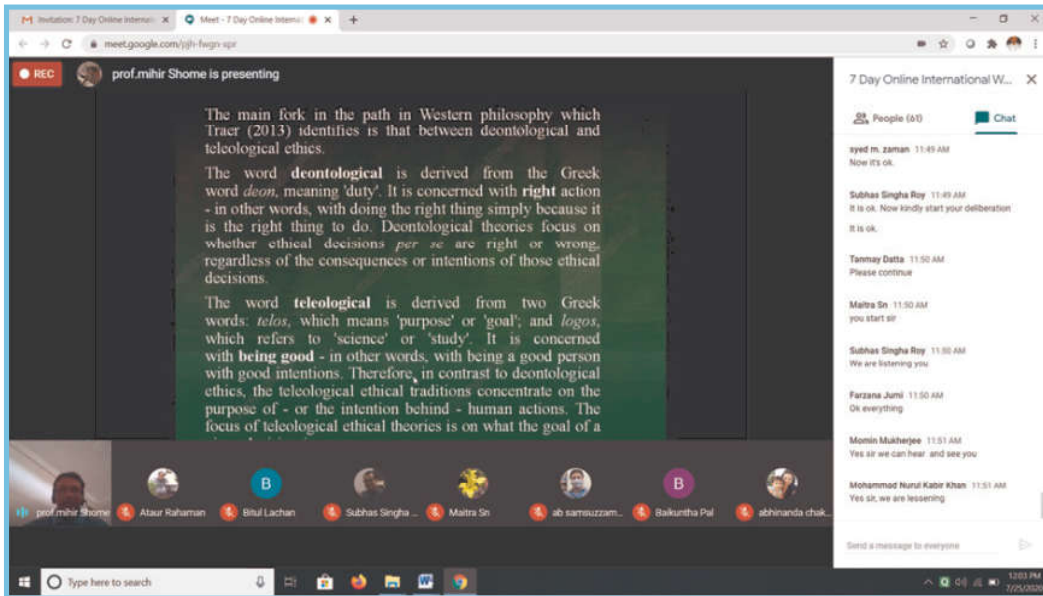
Technical Session: 5

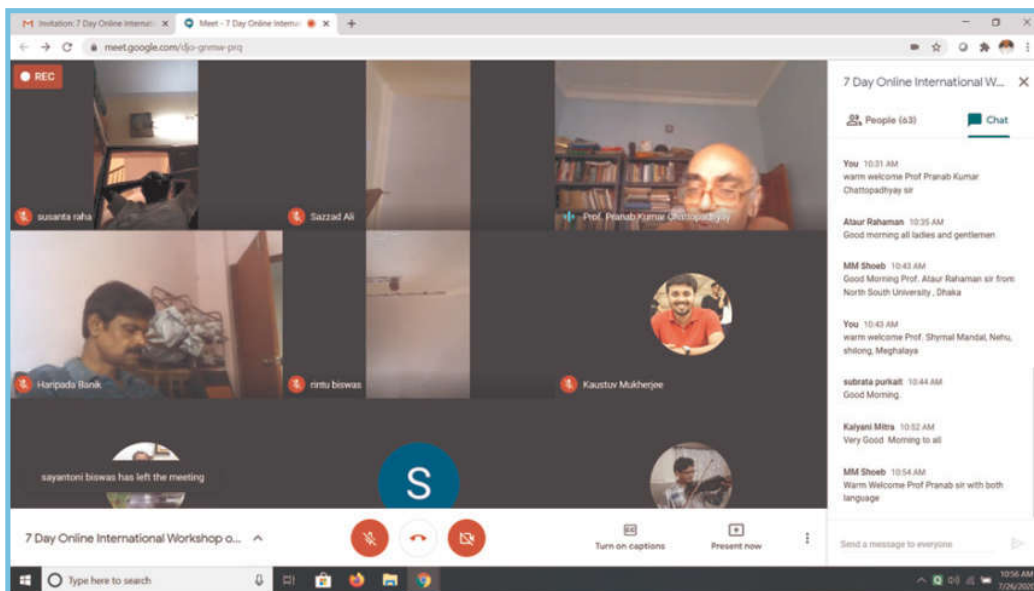

Day 6, 26th July, Sunday, 2020

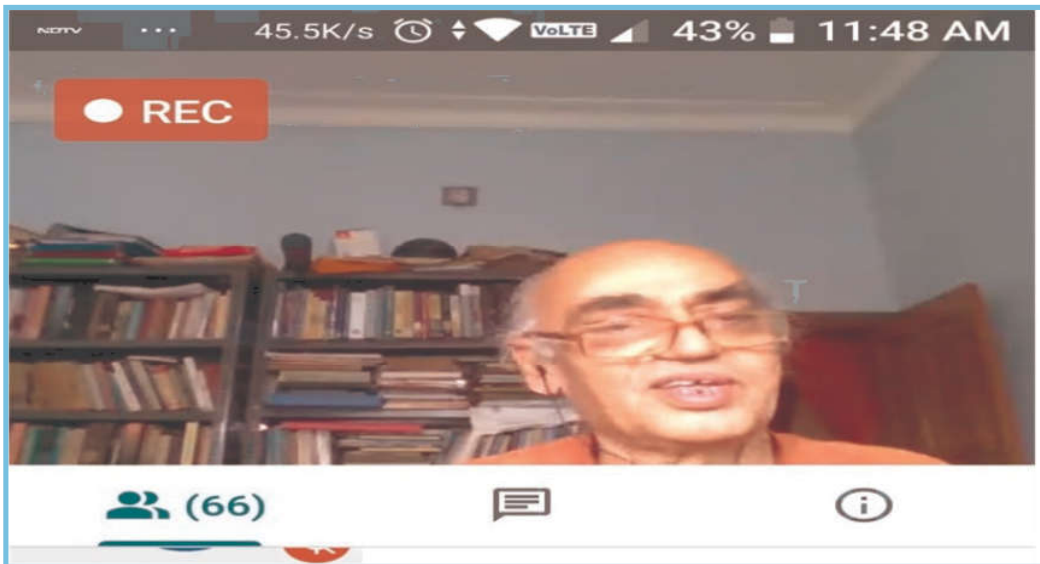
Technical Session:6

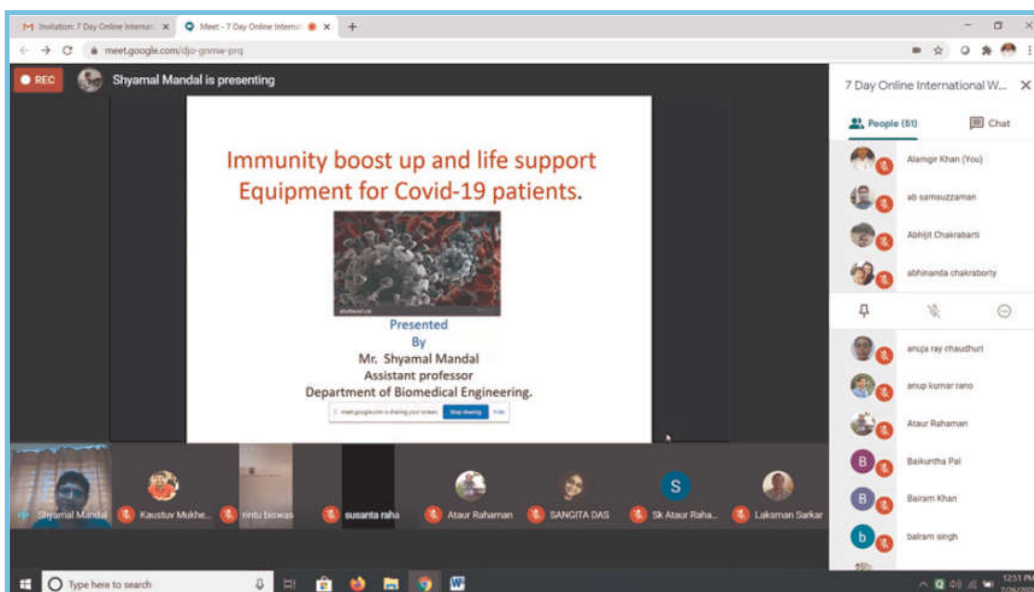

He mentioned the ways and the role of the Govt. to relieve the distress of the Micro Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) & migrant workers. In this Context he pointed out that the Govt. needs more money from its own exchequer to the people through the process of infrastructural development in the country not mere to promise to infuse loan capital to the entrepreneurs at the uncertainties. He stressed that through money at the hand of the people may be helpful to enhance the purchasing power and thereby to increase the demands in the market. He expressed his hope that Indian economy will be able to find its way to revive in future when the normalcy will resume.

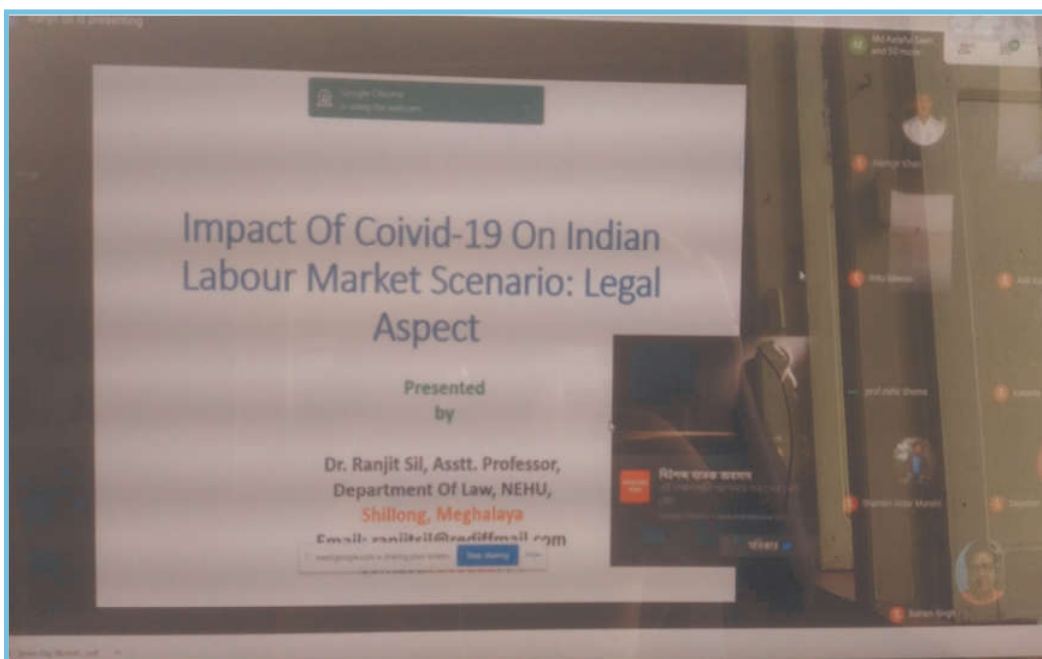

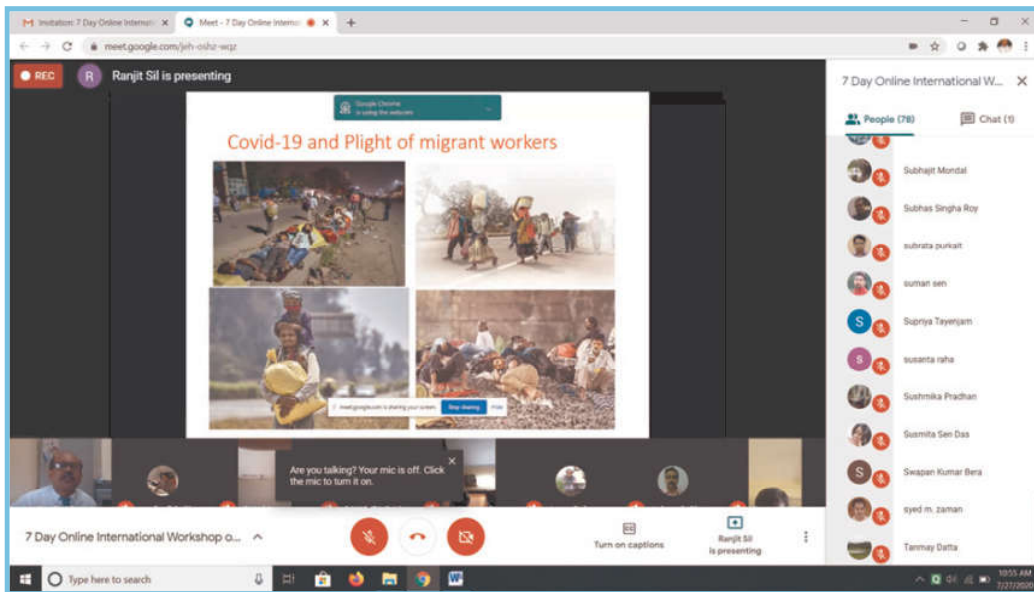

Prof. Ranjit Sil discussed elaborately how the recent Covid-19 situation has affected (situation is still worsening day by day) Indian labour market. He showed the severity of the organised sectors in India in the lockdown situation with lot of information. He pointed out that these sectors couldn't able to disburse salary and wages to their employees as they face huge loss with the passage of time. Their production, sale and entire chain of the system becoming jeopardised. In comparison to the situation of organised sector he then explained the unimaginable situation of the unorganized sectors and its employees. He also highlighted the effect of labour laws on the workers as reformed recently. He categorically explained several existing laws which can be enforced by the Government to protect the interest of the migrant workers. Here, he also suggested various workers' association and trade union to be more active to get registered all workers within the purview of several labour laws and thereby to protect the interest of the employees. Also he prescribed the Government to adopt some

measures to plug the loopholes of the existing laws with a view to give protection in all aspects of the labours. At the end he was asked various questions by the participants and answered very precisely.

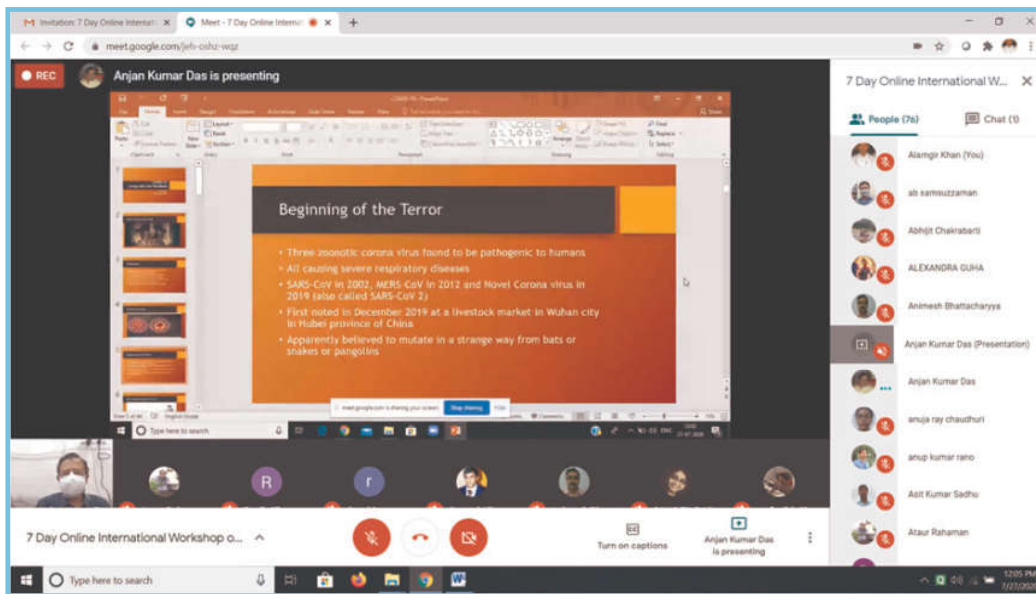
Technical Session: 9

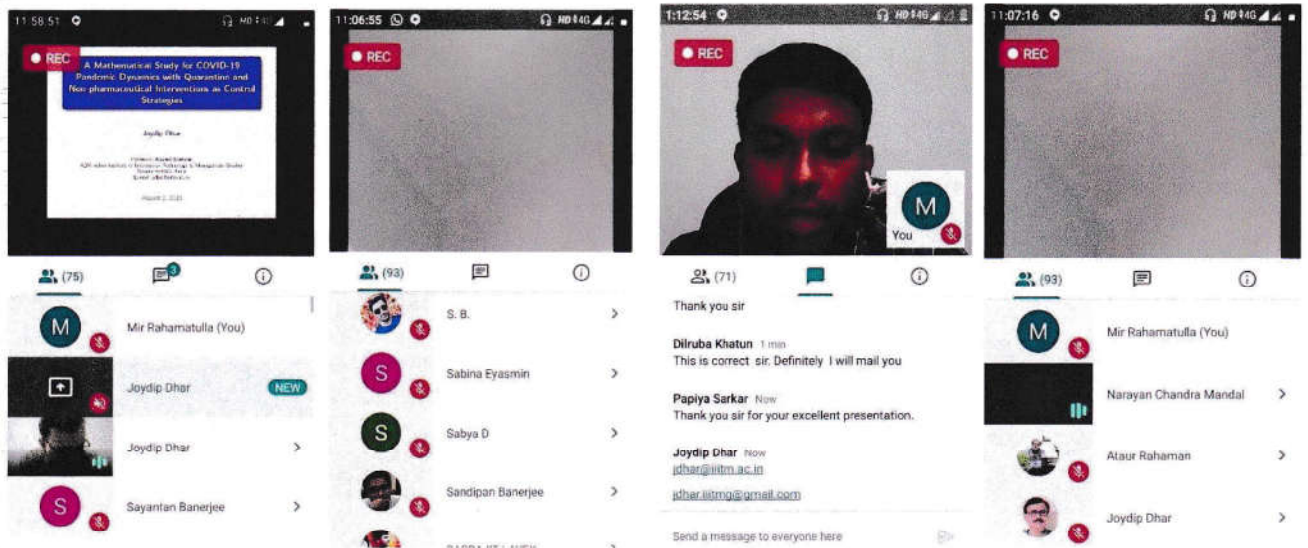

Starting with the history of Corona Virus, its different types, its infectivity, its prevention and its medication he cleared very simplistically all of our doubts and misconception. His speech was really an eye-opener for all of us. He stressed on the preventive aspects to fight against this virus, as there is no medicine.

He highlighted the most common symptoms of this viral infection-like fever, cold, cough, and bone pain and breathing problems, and ultimately leading to pneumonia. He presented very effective guidelines which only are protective for us to live with pandemic-like hygiene protocol (washing of hands, avoidance of close proximity to other people, washing and sanitising of daily usable or edible articles,
